Club Calendar

May 1, Big Green Lake Outing – It's opening day. The destination for this outing is the mill pond boat launch right in Green Lake. To get there, go through Ripon on Highway 23, then take Business 23 into town. Turn right on Canal Street and go one block to the boat launch. Fishing hours are 8 a.m. until 4 p.m.

May 6, Regular Meeting – We will discuss the many club events scheduled for the month of May at this meeting.

May 8, Little Green Lake Outing – From Fox Lake in Dodge County, go five miles west on Highway 33 to Highway 73, then turn right (north). Go north on Highway 73 about 10 miles to Highway 44 and turn right. Go six miles and watch for The Landing sign a little north of Markesan. Fishing hours are 7 a.m. until 3 p.m.

May 15, Mason Lake Outing – We'll use our usual boat launch at the Wagon Wheel Campground on the south side of the lake. Take

Highway 23 to just west of Briggsville, where the campground sign is visible on the right side of the road. Follow the signs to the boat launch, and don't forget to pay the parking fee or you will get a ticket. Fishing hours are 7 a.m. until 3 p.m.

May 20, Nagawicka On-The-Water Meeting – The first On-The-Water Meeting of 2010 will be at Lake Nagawicka, and we'll use the county boat launch in Naga-Waukee Park. Hours are 6-9 p.m., and pre-fishing is not allowed the day of the meeting.

May 22, Madison Chain Outing – The boat launch for this outing is at Babcock Park, on the east side of Lake Waubesa. Take I-94 west toward Madison, then I-90 south toward Janesville. Exit I-90 at the Beltline Highway (Hwy. 12/18 West), and go a short distance to Highway 51 (Stoughton Road). Go south less than three miles to Babcock Park on the right side of the road. Hours are 7 a.m. to 3 p.m.

■ The season is here, so let's go over a couple housekeeping items:

First of all, there have been no real changes made when it comes to the running of club outings in 2010. We hope everyone shows up for as many of them as they can throughout the season (and everyone catches a lot of fish). But, if you arrive to an outing late – which is OK – you will have to find another club member on the water to have your livewell checked before you start fishing. Of course, you also still have to pay the entry fee afterward.

If there are any proposed changes to the operation of outings this year, we will discuss them at a club meeting. Then we'll explain them in the newsletter before they are voted on at the next meeting.
